- Impersonates any person or misrepresent your identity or affiliation with any person.
- Advocates, promotes, incites any party to commit, or assist any unlawful or criminal act such as (by way of example only) copyright infringement or computer misuse.
- Is defamatory of any person.
- Is obscene, offensive, hateful or inflammatory.
- Infringes any copyright, database right or trademark of any other person.

You also agree:

- Not to reproduce, duplicate, copy, or re-sell any part of our site in contravention of the provisions of our Terms of Website Use.
- Not to conduct, facilitate, or authorize any automated data extraction, web scraping, data mining, or indexing of our technical files, text, or layouts.
