About this cookie policy

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are and how we use them. You should read this policy to understand the types of cookies we use, the information we collect using cookies, how that information is used, and how to control your cookie preferences. For further information on how we use, store, and keep your personal data secure, see our [Privacy Policy](#) which explains in further detail how we process personal data and the lawful bases we rely on under UK data protection legislation.

You can at any time change or withdraw your consent from the Cookie Declaration on our website free of charge.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are used to store small pieces of information. They are stored on your device when the website is loaded on your browser. These cookies help us make the website function properly, make it more secure, provide a better user experience, and analyse how the website performs so we can understand what works and where it needs improvement.

How do we use cookies?

Like most online services, our website uses first-party and third-party cookies for a number of purposes.



- First-party cookies: First-party cookies are placed by us when you visit the site. These cookies are primarily used to enable core functionality of the website, such as maintaining your session and ensuring security. They do not usually collect information that directly identifies you.
 - Third-party cookies: Third-party cookies are set by external providers (such as analytics or service providers). These cookies help us understand how the website is used, improve performance, and may be used to deliver relevant content or services. Where such cookies are non-essential, they will only be used with your consent..

What types of cookies may we use?

Essential

Some cookies are essential for you to be able to experience the full functionality of our site. They allow us to maintain user sessions and prevent any security threats. They do not store any cross-site tracking information. For example, these cookies allow you to securely log in to your account, manage requests, or access secure client areas.

Analytical or Performance

These cookies store information like the number of visitors to the website, the number of unique visitors, which pages of the website have been visited, and the source of the visit. This data helps us understand and analyse how well the website performs and where it needs improvement, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

We use Google Analytics for this purpose. Because Google Analytics processes unique online identifiers (such as IP addresses and client IDs) to compile these insights, these cookies are non-essential and will remain entirely blocked until you explicitly opt-in via our cookie banner.

Functional

These are cookies that support certain non-essential functionalities on our website. These functionalities include embedding content like videos or sharing content from the website onto social media platforms. These cookies may remember user preferences (such as language or region) to enhance your experience of the website.

Targeting

These cookies record your visit to our website, including the pages you have viewed. This information may be used to make content and communications more relevant to users. We may share this information with carefully selected third parties where appropriate and subject to your consent.

_ga	Analytical or Performance	2 Years	Installed by Google Analytics to calculate visitor, session, and campaign data for site analytics.
_gat_gtag	Analytical or Performance	Until browser is closed	Used by Google Analytics to store the unique website identification code for tracking visits.
_gid	Analytical or Performance	1 Day	Used by Google Analytics to store information on how visitors use the website for reporting.
cookieLawInfo-checkbox-necessary	Essential	Until browser is closed	Set by our cookie consent manager to remember if you accepted necessary technical cookies.
PHPSESSID	Essential	Until browser is closed	Native to PHP applications; manages and maintains your unique user session on the site.
viewed_cookie_policy	Essential	1 Year	Set by our cookie consent manager to remember whether or not you have interacted with the website's cookie consent banner.

How can I control cookie preferences?

When you first visit our website, you will be presented with a cookie consent banner. Non-essential cookies (such as Statistics, Functional, and Targeting cookies) are blocked by default and will not be deployed unless you explicitly choose to accept them.
